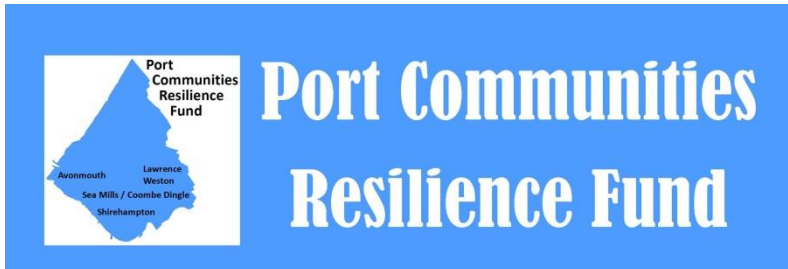

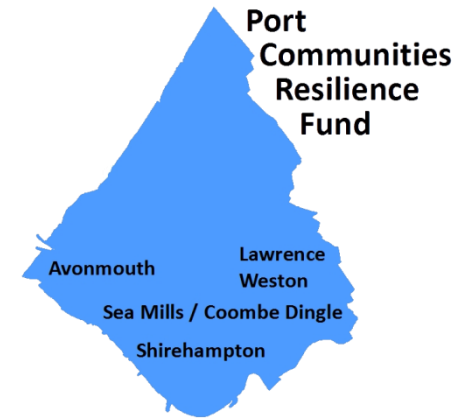


## WHAT IS PORT COMMUNITIES RESILIENCE FUND?

From the sale of Bristol Port, a £1m fund was setup for a range of improvements in Avonmouth & Lawrence Weston ward

Councillors, local residents and organisations met in November 2016. They agreed the funding should focus on three themes:

- Jobs and enterprise
- Improving community facilities
- Thriving high streets

# Resilience for Community Facilities in Avonmouth & Lawrence Weston ward...

The Community Facilities grant scheme aims to support the capacity of ... Community Groups and communities within Avonmouth & Lawrence Weston ward to **survive, adapt and grow** no matter what kinds of **chronic stresses** and **acute shocks** they experience'



# Eligibility



Projects applying to the Community Facilities fund can apply for between £10,000 – F100,000

They will also need to **match fund** the grant they ask for at a rate of **at least 100%**

# Match can include:



## Match 1 – at the project delivery – capital phase:

- **In kind donations** of construction materials
- **Cost price/reduced-price** construction materials or equipment.
- **Reduced-price labour contributions** (eg. a plumber who offers half-price rates; an architect who works for a discounted rate).
- **Volunteer labour time** (eg labour donated for free)
- **Existing reserves/savings** held by the organisation
- **Grants from other funders**
- **Sponsorship/donations**
- **Crowd Funded** and other fund-raised monies
- **Loans** negotiated to contribute to the build/refurbishment/purchase phase of the project
