



Travel Advice - Avonmouth



Cycling - Avonmouth is close to several towns including **Lawrence Weston** (1.9mi), **Shirehampton** (1.7mi) or **Sea Mills** (2.6mi). You can cycle along the Portway (A4) on a largely traffic free route from **Bristol** (7.6mi). There are marked routes on our [map](#). You may also choose to take your bike on the train and use **Avonmouth station**.



Walking - Avonmouth is walking distance from many towns which are walkable in under an hour, (see distances above). For those working locally in Avonmouth, there are regular trains arriving into Avonmouth station making walking a viable option.



Rail - There are regular rail services at **Avonmouth station** from **Bristol Temple Meads** that call at **Lawrence Hill, Stapleton Road, Montpellier, Redland, Clifton, Sea Mills, Shirehampton and Avonmouth**. Trains arrive from 0536 through till 2244. [Timetables](#) are on the GWR website. Rail services are relatively inexpensive at £3.10 return to Avonmouth from Bristol.
